



Upcoming Project: Michigan Avenue and 20th Street Bicycle and Pedestrian Connection Project Starting in June 2023 for 10 months duration

Dear Neighbors,

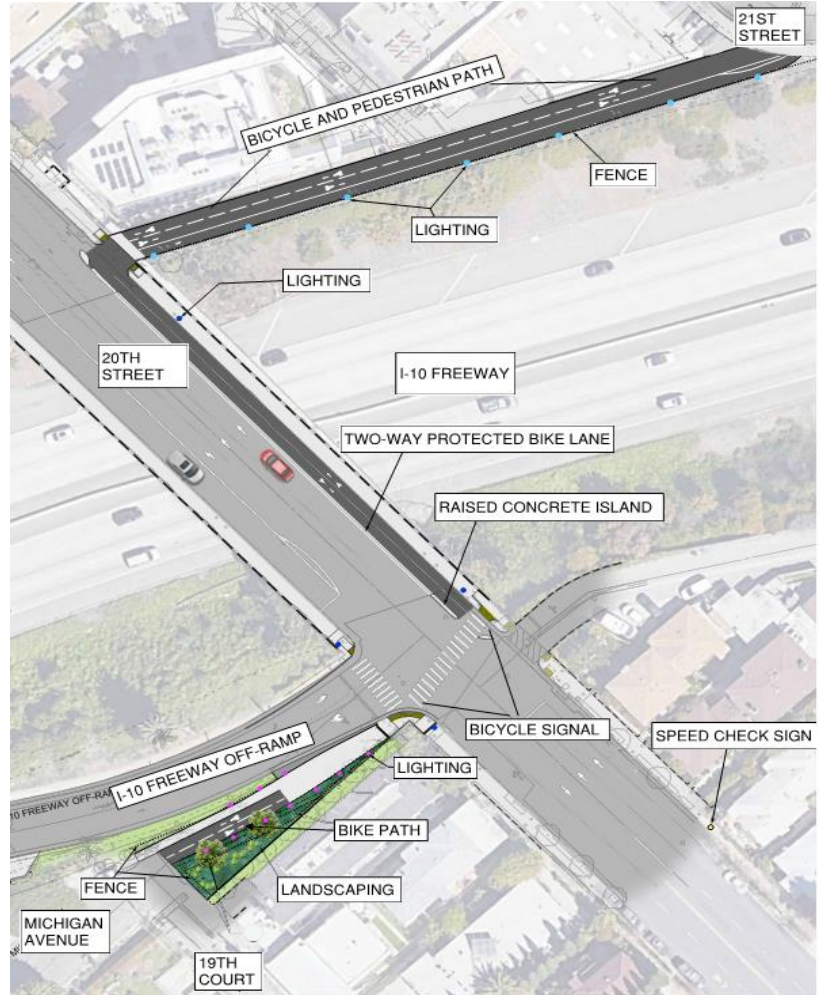
The City of Santa Monica has contracted with Access Pacific, Inc., for the Michigan Ave and 20th St Bicycle and Pedestrian Connection Project which will begin in June 2023 and last for 10 months.

This project will create new connections for people walking and biking in the vicinity by extending the Michigan Avenue Neighborhood Greenway east to 21st Street. Specifically, the project will install a pedestrian and bike path on the north side of the I-10 Freeway between 20th and 21st streets, a two-way protected bike lane on 20th St, and a bike path between 19th Ct and 20th St. For more details, please visit the project website at: <https://www.santamonica.gov/mobility-projects/20th-street-project>

The initial work will consist of utility pole relocation in mid-June 2023. If power outages are necessary, Southern California Edison (SCE) will notify affected residents in advance. Construction work will include the installation of the bike and pedestrian connections, lighting, fencing, landscaping, and pavement markings.

During the construction of the project, operation of heavy equipment will be necessary and there will be periods of intermittent loud noise during the construction. Dates are subject to change due to weather at which time a revised notice will be posted.
